The freedom that Jesus wants us to experience is marked by the Holy Spirit who brings love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, gentleness, faithfulness and self-control. With God's help, examine your life and see where you need God's truth to lead you into greater freedom. And remember, an examined life is just the beginning – once we've 'looked in the mirror' we may well need help to make the necessary changes.

Psalm 139 is a helpful psalm to pray with:

Search me O God and know my heart; Test me and know my anxious thoughts. See if there is an offensive way in me, And lead me in the way everlasting



Names of God - I am the Truth

John 14:6

Jesus said: I am the way the truth and the life. No-one comes to the Father except through me.

John 8:31-36

- ³¹ To the Jews who had believed him, Jesus said, "If you hold to my teaching, you are really my disciples. ³² Then you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free."
